On Monday, March 21, 2022, face-coverings will become optional for S.E.A.L. employees, in addition to being optional for S.E.A.L. students. Administration and Leadership will continue to monitor both local metrics, as well as observe our internal positivity data. If it is felt that our environment is being affected by the reduction in mitigation measures, S.E.A.L. may decide to reinforce face-covering rules for all who enter our buildings at a later date.

Though face-coverings are optional for all who enter our buildings, we continue to strongly recommend face-coverings when indoors. Visitors will be offered disposable masks when checking in at the front desk, but we will no longer require visitors to wear face-covering on tours or during meetings.

In the two weeks since lifting the mask requirement for our students, S.E.A.L. is encouraged by the very small number of positive cases we have seen, and hope that we see this trend continue with the mild weather and increased opportunities for our students to get outdoors.

We would like to remind all members of the S.E.A.L. community of the following important information:

- Symptoms of COVID-19 must still be reported to your location's health office. The health office employee will advise families on necessary procedures as well as a probable return date for your student.
- If a student tests positive and is asymptomatic, they must quarantine for at least 5 days from their positive test.
- If a student has tested positive and is symptomatic, they must quarantine for at least 5 days from the date their symptoms began.
- If a student was asymptomatic, or their symptoms have resolved (including no fever for 24 hours) after 5 days, they must wear a mask in school for 5 additional (calendar) days.
