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STUDENT COVID-19 IN-SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

S.E.A.L. continues to follow CDC, IDPH and ISBE guidelines to minimize the risk and exposure of SARS-CoV-2 to both students and staff. It is our goal during any such time period to strive for effective operation while ensuring that all essential services are being provided as we keep our students and staff safe within the school environment.

We have taken the necessary steps to prepare our buildings for re-entry in January 2022; supplying the proper equipment and disinfecting materials as well as establishing safety procedures and protocols. We will continually monitor our school's environment and adjust as needed.

We are **requiring all guardians to adhere to the following requirements** in order to reduce the transmission of infectious disease in the school buildings on a daily basis:

- Perform a daily symptom check with your child **before** they board transportation to come to school **each morning**
- If any of the following symptoms are present, you must notify S.E.A.L., and your child must be kept home and tested for COVID-19 within 24 hours **regardless of vaccination status**
 - fever (100.4°F or higher)
 - new onset of moderate to severe headache
 - shortness of breath, new cough
 - sore throat
 - vomiting
 - diarrhea
 - new loss of sense of taste or smell
 - fatigue from unknown causes of muscle or body aches from unknown causes
- If your child has been exposed to COVID-19 please contact the health staff at your child's campus for further guidance
